As the Ministry of Education has issued a directive to suspend on-campus classes until April 5, a letter sent by the university in this regard.

- AGU campus is NOT OPEN to students during that period.
- AGU faculty will utilize Blackboard Learning Management System (Bb) to post related course material. Use Bb and your AGU email to communicate with your faculty.
- There will be no examination during the distant-learning period. Previously scheduled exams during the 4 weeks suspension period are postponed.
- Assignments are to be submitted via Blackboard as per the deadlines stated by your instructor of your particular course.
